Please include the originally signed letter with your application form and other attachments.

Applications will be accepted between March 1 and June 15 each year

### Selection Procedure

The Selection Committee will consider an applicant's program of study, academic achievement, and personal strengths as presented in the short essay and reference letter. If selected, the scholarship of \$2,000.00 will be paid directly to the Financial Office of the student's current educational institution. This application indicates the applicant's consent to post the photo and short essay of the successful recipient of the scholarship to the Katherine Lemke Heinrichs Scholarship website.

The decision will be made by August 31st and the successful recipient will be notified by email.

The Selection Committee thanks all students for their efforts in applying for the Scholarship, however, only those who have been selected will be notified. It is an important area of study and unfortunately plenty of work is still required to prevent or alleviate the situations whereby people find themselves as refugees or as displaced persons.
